The Greene County Board met in special session on May 27, 2026, at 7 pm. The Chair called the meeting to order. The Clerk called roll. Those members present were Earlene Castleberry, Robert Hall, Charlie Helton, David Hicks, Cary Knox, and Joshua Lawson. Julie Rhoades, County Insurance Agent, was also present.

Discussion began regarding the County health insurance plans. Julie explained to the board that they would no longer be able to consider plans through United Healthcare since United Healthcare does not share claim information to third party vendors. The county currently utilizes Chard Snyder/WEX Health to reimburse employees for copays and out-of-pocket expenses. The County would have to remain with a Blue Cross Blue Shield plan to continue using the third party for reimbursements.

Motion was made by Lawson, seconded by Hall, to approve the MIBPP2116 Blue Cross Blue Shield plan for renewal effective 7/1/2026. The Chair called for a roll call vote: Castleberry, yes; Hall, yes; Helton, yes; Hicks, yes; Knox, yes; and Lawson, yes.
